

Preparation checklist

Cabinets need to be level, flat and secured to the foundation properly.
A 5/8" sub deck or "rough top" needs to overlay the top of the cabinets and flush with frames. 5/8" OSB or plywood should be used. See illustrations.
All parts of the cabinets need to be installed and in place. Including cabinet end panels and drawer fronts.
All sinks, cutouts, ranges and or cooktops need to be on-site or installed before we can measure.
Faucet holes: How many and location.
Undermount sinks can be mounted in place by mounting them flush with the sub deck. Must have at least ¼" play side-to-side and front to back. Sinks are not to be glued in place. See illustrations
Overhangs should be made using sub deck and corbels or aluminum underlayment, which Design Images can provide.


2cm with 1 ½" Edge, Sub deck on top "Standard"
